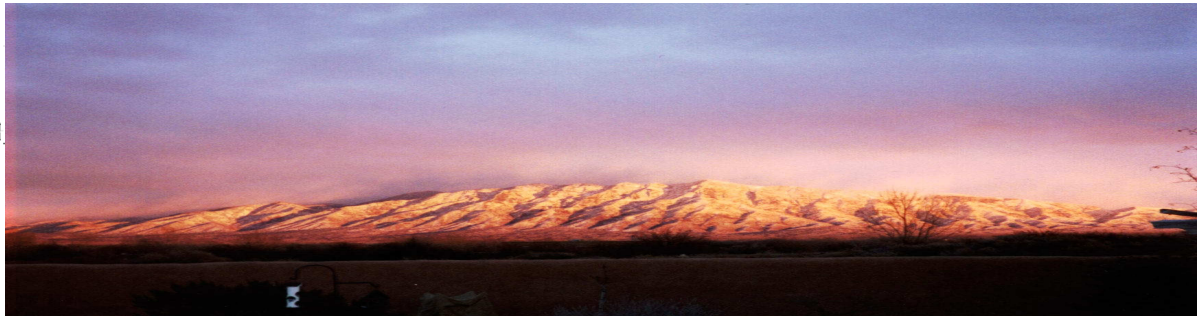

SEPTEMBER MEETING

We are delighted to have Dr. Larry Waldman as the featured speaker for the annual joint dinner meeting of the three organizations - NMAEE, ASHRAE, NMFMN - to be held **Wednesday evening, September 17, 2008 in the Eagle Room at the Sandia Casino & Resort Convention Area**. Dr. Waldman will speak about the New Mexico economy with regards to recent developments and their impacts, economic trends, and the economic outlook for the future.

Larry Waldman is a graduate of the University of New Mexico, receiving a mathematics BS in 1968 and an economics PhD in 1981. He is currently senior economist with the Bureau of Business and Economic Research at UNM, and is a faculty member at the Department of Economics at UNM, the Anderson Schools of Management at UNM, and Central New Mexico Community College (formerly Albuquerque TVI).

His professional interests include economic forecasting and research into the New Mexico economy. His primary responsibility at the Bureau of Business and Economic Research is the operation of the FOR-UNM (pronounced 'forum') Economic Forecasting Service, which generates quarterly income and employment forecasts for the state and major metropolitan areas (Albuquerque, Las Cruces, and Santa Fe). Recent research topics include poverty in New Mexico, welfare reform, New Mexico economic history, water use, micro-electro-mechanical systems (MEMS) and biotechnology in New Mexico.
