Don Paxton, Bob Smith, J.H. Van Alsburg, Neal Vinson**

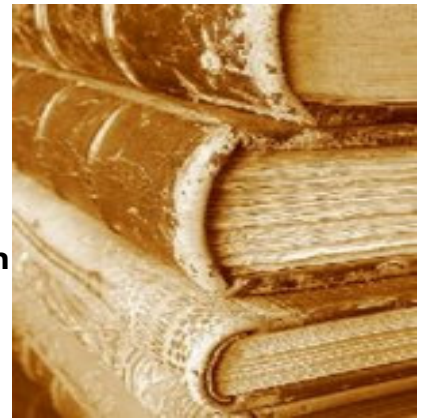

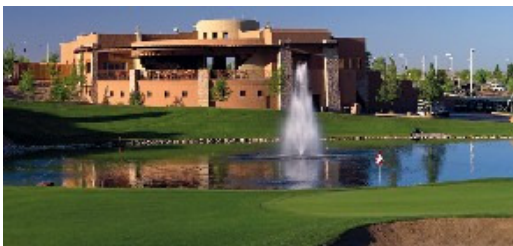
